A Note from the Director



Dear Parents-

It's hard to believe that it's only two weeks away from our winter break! Things are getting busier and busier, with the PTO winter celebration in our lobby on December 7, to the school play "Shakey Squared" on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of next week, to the middle school science fair on the afternoon of Thursday, December 8. The following week brings us winter concerts and, of course, Friday, December 16 as our last day of school.

Our capable maintenance staff is working overtime to ensure that buses are running, paths are clear, and hallways are clean, though at times the snow wins this battle. But with snow comes cancellations, so again we ask that you make sure your contact information is kept up to date with us so that we can notify you in case of closures or other emergencies.

We hope that you have a wonderful weekend in this winter wonderland, and we look forward to a busy and successful last two weeks before a break.



Students Learn, Teach, and Grow in IB Economics

Secondary III IB Economics students have just completed a unit on "elasticity", or the ways in which consumption and production respond to changes in market prices. In alignment with QSI success orientations, Mr Lyons' IB Economics classes place a lot of emphasis on student initiative, responsibility, self-direction, and cooperation in learning. For the elasticity unit, students worked in pairs and groups to first develop a basic mastery of the related skills and concepts. They then taught their peers through class presentations and sit-down discussions. Throughout this process Mr Lyons served primarily as a guide or "facilitator", becoming involved in the activity only as needed for clarification, or to help organize and focus the learning process. Assessment was then embedded in the student-driven learning activities or aligned with the those activities after completion. Students seem to genuinely grow from and enjoy opportunities to take ownership of their learning!
